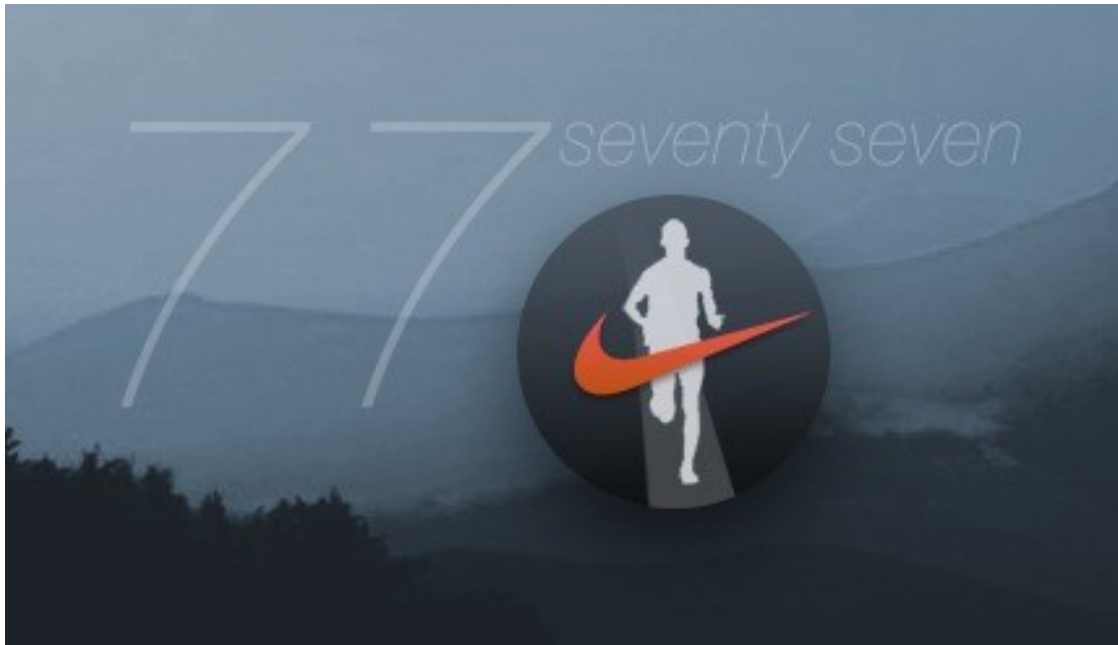

Loading Screens

Made for iOS 7 only: Harmonizes perfectly with your OS

Icon philosophy:

slightly transparent, dark, reduced graphics and depth (not fully flat), own color concept, no outdated skeuomorphisms or glossy overlays:



Setup:

1. Enable the **77.theme** and one of the icon style themes (e. g. **77 IconMaskCircular.theme**) at Winterboard

Optional you can also enable the **LoadingScreens** and the **Unlock-Slider** at Winterboard

2. **IconOmatic**: Choose any of the appropriate shadows for the Icon style you use at Winterboard

3. **iWidgets**: Long-press anywhere on your display and enable one or more 77 iWidgets and just make your setup at the pop-up menu.

Wallpapers

Winterboard currently doesn't support native theme Wallpapers like on iOS6. So all 77 Wallpapers are stored at the 77.theme folder, separated for iPhone 4 and 5 screen size. This are all parallax-optimized Wallpapers that are larger than the screensize (to not get scaled up and get blurry with iOS 7 😊)

a) With iFunBox or other free Software you can copy the Wallpapers to your computer and sync it back to your iPhone with iTunes.

b) Better (see video at modmyi): Open any Wallpaper with iFile and save it directly to your Camera roll.

->Now **choose your Wallpaper at the iOS Photos app** or at

Settings/Wallpapers

iWidgets:

Things to know:

- a) 77 widgets and Lockscreens fully **support GPS** based weather, but you need the tweaks *Widget Weather* (free at Cydia) or *MyLocation* from modmyi. If you use Widget Weather enable "MyLocation" at the bottom of the Widget Weather settings)
- b) To replace the girls **photo**: Rename any of your pictures to "Photo.png" (even if it's a .jpg-file). Size doesn't matter, the widget scales it for you. Copy it to this path: /User/Library/iWidgets/77 iWidget/Images/Photo.png
- c) Don't know your **location code** ? -> Open this website: www.weather.yahoo.com, type in your city at the search field and look at the adressbar of your browser, the 6 or 7 digits number at the end is your location code.

Zeppelin:

Open Settings/Zeppelin and choose one of the 77 logos.

Lockscreen themes

1. 77 Lockscreen themes are available at Cydia and free for Users of 77. Just search for "77" or "seventy seven" at Cydia.
2. Both Lockscreens have a HTC and 77 weather icon set included
3. You must have installed the free tweak "**GroovyLock**" from Cydia and must enable one of the 77 Lockscreens at
Settings -> GroovyLock
4. You can **setup** the weather icon set, language, 12/24 h, celsius/fahrenheit and many more at
User/Library/GroovyLock/77GroovyLock-screen.../Config.js
5. Lockscreen 1 includes alternative clockfaces, stored at: User/Library/GroovyLock/77GroovyLock-screen1/Images/clockface/
6. To hide the iOS clock use *CustomLS*, Springtomize 3 or similar tweaks with that function

Notes (read it please):

a) Many Winterboard features we all know from iOS 6 don't work on iOS 7 (like theme Wallpapers, HTML-Widgets, Icons-folder). So theming iOS 7 is very hard. I give my best to add more features if possible

b) The iOS 7 UI and springboard (like the folders) is nearly un-themeable as its partly coded and made with vector graphics.

b) To customize the dock like i did on my previews you can use the free tweak "DockShift"

INSTRUCTIONS for the TWITTER WIDGET:

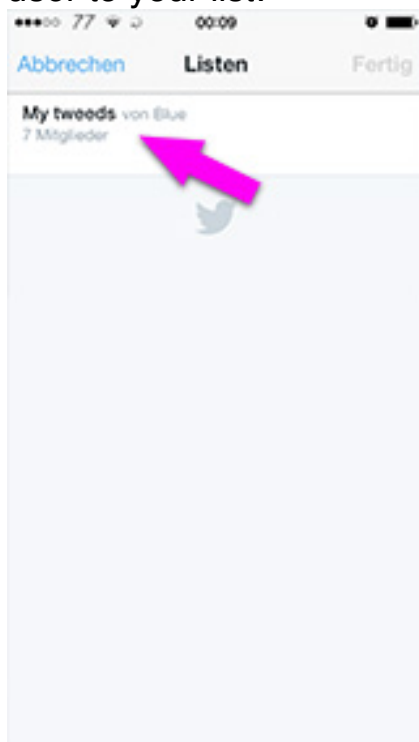
1. First we must create a **List of Twitter users you want to follow**. You can do this directly on your iDevice. Start your Twitter app, choose a Twitter user you want to follow with the iWidget, e. G. MacCiti and press the **settings icon**:



Now a menu pops up, choose **add/remove to list**:



Now a **menu with your List(s) pops up**. Press on your list to add this user to your list:

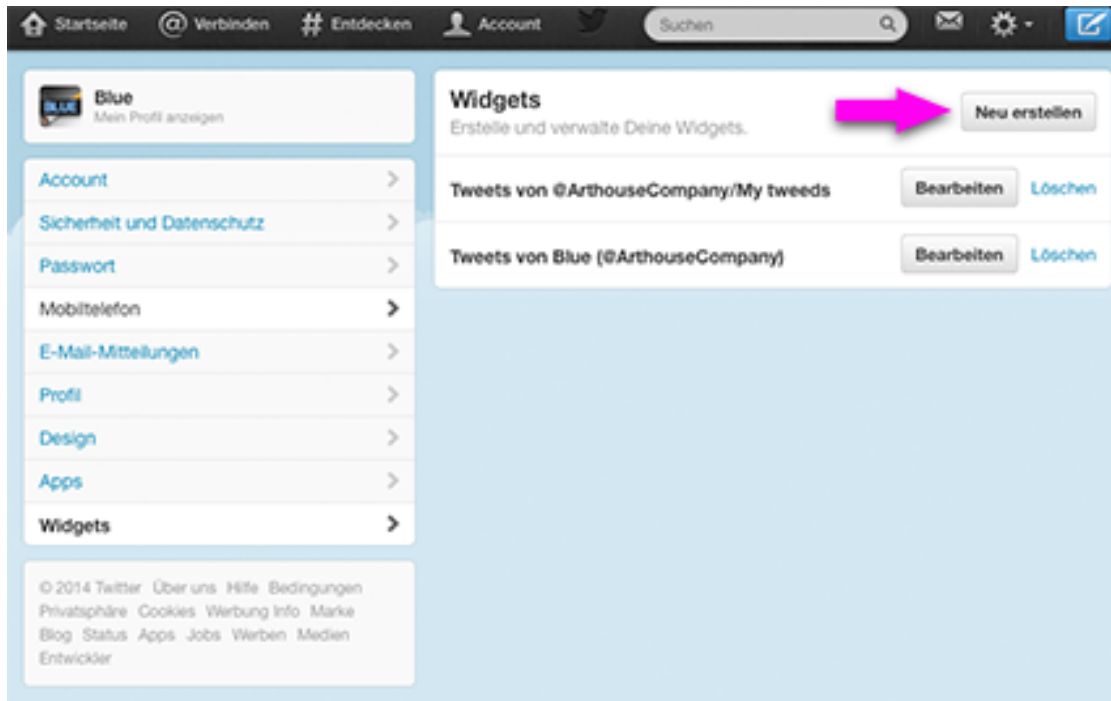


Note: You can later add or remove any user to/from this list directly on your iDevice. The iWidget will always be up to date.

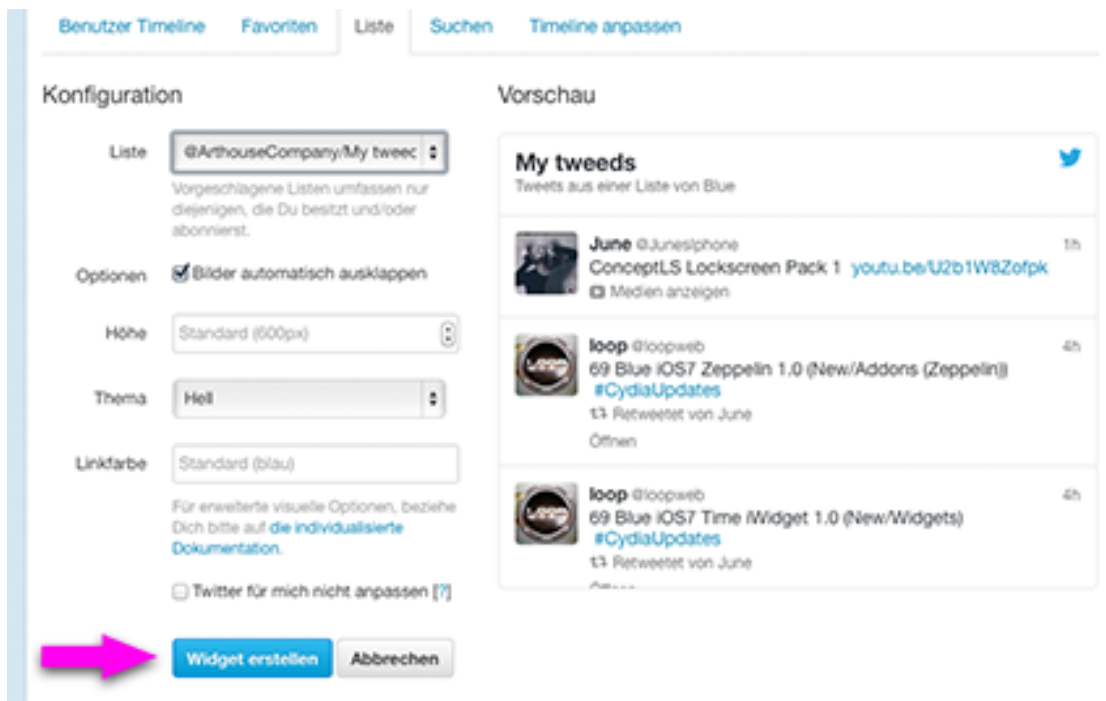
2 Now we need a **Widget ID/Number** for your own **Twitter List**

Open <https://twitter.com/settings/widgets> and log in to your Twitter account.

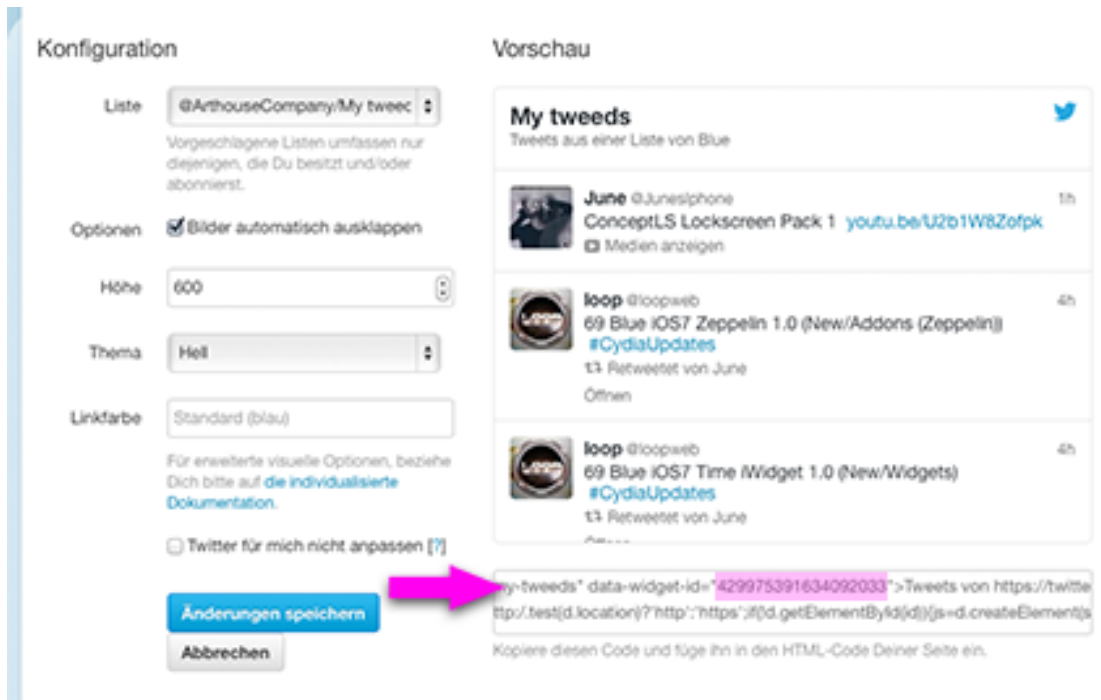
choose: **New Widget**



now choose **create Widget** (forget about all other settings at this website)



Now you see a widget code at bottom right. **Inside is your WidgetID/ Number** that we need for the iWidget.



Copy this number and paste it to the iWidget on your iDevice here:

> User/Library/iWidgets/ Blue's iWidget Twitter.../Widget.html:



That's ist. Make sure you **save this number** somewhere, in case this package will be updated. But you can also **see this number if you open the Twitter Website** (see link above) and choose your Twitter widget from there.

FAQ and HELP:

Clock/Date/Calendar Widgets supporting the following languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Turkish, Danish, Italian. Additionally the UniAWmini widgets supports Russian, Chinese, Dutch and Finnish, but not Danish. RSS Readers, Twitter, Clocks, Instagram and Slideshows work worldwide.

Do this widgets support GPS-located Weather ?

Yes, enable GPS at the widget menu. But you must have installed and enabled the free tweak 'Widget Weather' from Cydia. At the Settings App>WidgetWeather also make sure you've enabled MyLocation. The yahoo location code is irrelevant for the widgets now.

How can I setup the Twitter widget ?

Can i use own photos for the Slideshow widgets ?

Yes, just name 10 of your pictures to "1.png". "2.png" and so on. Name them ".png" even if it's a ".jpg" file. Just copy your pictures to this path on your device: `/User/Library/iWidgets/77 iWidget Slideshow.../Private/Photos/...here...` The size doesn't matter, the widget scales it for you.

Why doesn't my RSS widget show photos to the news ?

This depends on the source you've chosen, some rss-feeds generally don't provide photos or sometimes show news without photos. Also the text and photo layout may differ depending on the rss-feed you've chosen.

Can I add more sources/feeds to the RSS-iWidgets ?

Yes, open the **Options.plist** file inside the rss widget folder. Copy the code of one of the sources (e.g: `<key>Yahoo Sports....</string>`) and paste it below the last source. Now rename "Yahoo Sports" to

whatever you like and replace the yahoo rss feed (HTTP://.....<) with another feed. Next time you can also choose your rss-feed at the iWidget menu

Can the Instagram Slidehows display my own instagram photos?

Yes, currently it displays photos only based on hashtags.

- Open this website: [SnapWidget | Instagram Widget](#)
- choose "free widget", add your user name at "Customize widget" and press "get widget".

- Now you get your source code, looks like this:

```

(Forget the other code there).

- Now open the file **Widget.html at my Instagram Widget** and override ONLY this (red) part of the code with your new code:

//**Earth Pics**

- If you want to rename "Earth Pics" do this above the code and also at my file **Options.plist**

- Save your new Instagram widget. Just make a copy and name the Widget "My Instagram iWidget" (otherwise your changes at the original

widget will be overridden with any update)

What is IconoOmatic ?

iOS 7 no longer supports drop shadows for icons, so with this free tweak you can add shadows and overlays to icons. I made 9 different shadows,
3 for each included icon style. Choose 77 Shadows at Winterboard.

Why don't my Icons change ?

iOS stores all used icons also at a **cache folder** for faster loading.

-> Install and run the free Cydia tweak "**iCleaner**" and clean the cache or manually delete this cached icons here:

```
/var/mobile/Library/Caches/com.apple.IconsCache/.....here....
```

After that do a **reboot**. For a unthemed **Newsstand icon** also delete

```
this cached file here: /var/mobile/Library/Caches/  
com.apple.springboard.sharedimagecache/Persistent/  
NewsstandIconInternational.cpbitmap
```

Why is my BiteSMS icon not themed ?

Currently Bite SMS Beta isn't theme-able out of the box for any theme, because it replaces Apples Messages icon and then all users, even

without BiteSMS, would have it instead the Messages icon. DO this:

1. You can find my BiteSMS icon at ...77.theme/Other Icons/**BiteSMS.png**. Rename this graphic to **icon@2x~iphone.png** (Case sensitive)

and copy it to ...77.theme/com.apple.mobileSMS/...here...

2. Open the the contacts section of BiteSMS and pull down. There's a Settings menu. Then click on "more" and change to Apple messages (icon).

Clean your cache (manually or with iCleaner), REBOOT and it works.

Why can't we use the well known Icons folder of Winterboard for easily adding icons ?

Winterboard currently doesn't fully support this feature on iOS7, you will see the original icon when starting an app or moving an app into a folder.

Why does 77 GroovyLock-screen1 not work on my device ?

This happens on iPhone 4 and 4s and I will fix that soon.

Can i release Icons here or add own icons to my theme ?

Yes, but PLEASE post only **tested correct bundle folders with right named icons**. How ?

You must open the main folder of the app you want to theme. You can find your apps at **/User/Applications/** and at **/Applications/**.

Now e. g. open the folder /User/Applications/Facebook/Facebook.app/.

1. Here you can find all app icons, often a lot for universal apps. But iOS7 uses for the Retina iPhones generally only 3 icons at this

dimensions: **40x40p, 58x58p and 120x120p**. All apps name them different, but often the size or name helps identifying it:

icon_120 or icon 60x60@2x, or AppIcon58.png and so on. Make 3 new icons at the right size and name them right like they are named at

this app folder.

2. Inside each app folder is always a text-file called **info.plist**. Open it with any text software/editor or directly with iFile and search for the

line "**bundle identifier**". Below you can find the right name for

your folder, always **starting with com.....** Now make a new folder, name it

with com..., copy your new icons inside the folder, copy your folder to 77.theme/Bundles/...here. **Clean your icons cache, reboot** and it will work.

Why aren't there more parts of the springboard, like badges or folders, themed ?

Because currently it's unclear how to theme this or if it's even possible because many parts of the UI are no longer graphics but coded.

Can i place the iWidgets anywhere ?

Yes, simply press long on any iWidget and drag it around. You can also place the app icons anywhere on your screen with this Cydia tweaks:

iBlank for iOS 7, HomescreenDesigner, Gridlock or Iconoclasm. I recommend Gridlock, nothing is easier for that job.
